Introduction

The 1000i supports a USB port so you can connect to a Bluetooth headset using a BT dongle and provides LCD menu for Bluetooth setting.

The LCD menu for Bluetooth will be shown only when a Bluetooth dongle is installed.

- Adding/deleting/management of Bluetooth headset is possible only with phone menu without system setting, but headset mode must be set in system menu to use Bluetooth headset.
- To be able to answer to an incoming ring with a button on the headset, the Bluetooth headset always operates the ring regardless of the headset ring mode.
- Because the 1000i only supports the Bluetooth headset profile (HSP), you can only (1) answer an incoming ring or (2) end a call with the button on the headset.

- 2) The Bluetooth and Wi-Fi dongle cannot be used together, only one must be used.


Soft Buttons and Bluetooth Status Icon


The button functions used in the Bluetooth setup menu

Buttons	Functions
BACK	Return to the previous screen.
OK	Executes the selected menu.
ON	Turn on the Bluetooth
OFF	Turn off the Bluetooth
SEARCH	Search for Bluetooth Headsets again.
PAIR	Add the searched BT headset and connect it.
CANCEL	Stop the action in progress.
CONNECT	Connect the BT headset from the saved list.
DISCONNECT	Disconnect from the connected BT headset, but data is retained.
DELETE	Disconnect from the connected/saved BT and erase all data.
SEARCH	Search for BT headsets again.
◀ or ▶	Means there is an additional Soft menu, use the Left/Right navigation buttons.
Navi or Volume Up/Down	It is used to move to the desired BT headset on the headset list screen.
EXIT	It is used to exit the Bluetooth menu.

How to set up Bluetooth

[LCD]

The Bluetooth setting menu is only displayed when the Bluetooth dongle is installed, so you must first plug the dongle into the USB port on the back of the phone.

Procedure for setup :

- Step 0. Connect Bluetooth USB dongle
- Step 1. Turn-on Phone
- Step 2. Search & Connect Bluetooth Headset
- Step 3. Disconnect Bluetooth headset
